3	Minutes	RP introduced LO who advised he was responding to a request for Cockburn Police to address the group to discuss what measures are being taken to curb unlicensed motor cycles around the streets. LO advised the Police had ongoing operations in conjunction with the Aerial Division targeting suburbs from Fremantle to Rockingham. RP suggested the group compile a list of places of concern and pass them on to LO. DH noted that Lees Park & Deepdene Park are especially targeted by unlicensed motor cycles on a Sunday Afternoon. LO advised there is a 24 hour contact number (131 444) to report anti social behaviour. LO advised that the Police will always need a supporting statement from a witness if they are to be successful in Court.
