Fran Logan will be writing to the remaining owners.</p> <p>Regarding the insurance issue PvG advised the Act allows for a continuance of non conforming uses and is a superior document to the Master Plan. Should any landowner be provided with contrary views by insurance representatives then this matter should be taken up with the Insurance Council of WA.</p> <p>JM noted the footpath on the corner of Wattleup and Rockingham Roads was in a state of disrepair.
